RECOMMENDED PRUDENT & PRECAUTIONARY ACTIONS BY BUSINESSES AGAINST COVID-19

As the coronavirus continues to spread globally, the Business community of Kouga needs to take measures to ensure business can continue without putting employees, customers and their families, as well as our communities, at risk. There is no “fit for all” recipe and each business will have to discuss and taking their own steps to address the challenges posed by COVID-19.

As part of our commitment to help slow the spread of the virus, the Business community needs to take several prudent and precautionary actions, aimed at minimising risk to their employees and the community in general. These steps are aligned to the guidance provided by Government and the World Health Organisation:

- All employees need to be trained and equipped with the necessary tools to implement heightened cleaning and hygiene protocols in the workplace with immediate effect.

(Sanitizer to be available freely for hands, high-contact areas and equipment to be meticulously deep-cleaned frequently)
- In the workplace, restaurants, etc. ensure that employees or customers are moved further apart (at least 1,5m)
- Pending on the size of your business or work force, try to split sections or employees into teams with the minimum of contact between these teams. Should one of the team members fell ill to the virus and that team needs to go into quarantine, the other team will still be able to continue and keep the business running.
- If possible, implement a work-from-home strategy for most of your employees to not only keep them as safe as possible but to also prevent the spread of the virus.
- We're encouraging that all meetings, where possible, be held virtually (Skype) or via teleconferencing.
- It is recommended that all international and local travel is limited to business-critical requirements only.
- Any colleagues or employees returning from travel to high-risk countries or high-risk areas from within our country, will be required to self-quarantine for 2 weeks from their date of return.
- Any colleagues or employees who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or feel poorly while at work, will be required to self-isolate and consult their healthcare practitioner.
- All events must be cancelled or postponed until more clarity is available on when these can safely resume.
- It is recommended that businesses run a tight budget as a slump in the local economy is to be expected.

Die dagbestuur het reeds Woensdag 18 Maart 2020 begin met samesprekings wat gelei word deur die Kouga Munisipaliteit (KM) en verskeie rolspelers in Kouga om 'n COVID-19 aksieplan saam te stel.

'n Opvolg vergadering vind plaas op Vrydag 20 Maart 2020 om 15H00 om die maatreels en implimentering van aksieplanne te bespreek.

Daar bestaan tans verwarring tov die implimentering van regulasies soos gepubliseer in die Staatskoerant wat verwys na restaurante, kroë en plekke wat alkohol verkoop.

Na vele navrae van verskeie rolspelers het die KM die volgende riglyne aangedui. Hierdie mag verander maar is hoe die wet huidiglik toegepas sal word.

- Gelisensieerde Restaurante mag kos verkoop/bedien na 18:00 – **GEEN DRANK VERKOPE NA 18:00 NIE**
- Kapasiteit beperk tot 50 mense insluitend die personeel per besigheids perseel
- Kapasiteit is verder beperk tot 1 vierkante meter spasie per persoon op die perseel.

Die situasie en regulasies verander daaglik en die KBF sal sodra bevestiging en inligting ontvang word u verwittig.

Dear Kouga Business Forum member,

The Executive Committee of the Kouga Business Forum (KBF) is sending this letter with regards to the Covid-19 pandemic and where KBF stands. The KBF would like to ask each member to implement all measures regarding hygiene and extra protocol in your business in order to prevent the spread of the virus in Kouga or to try and minimize the effect.

The Executive Committee has already started on Wednesday 18 March 2020 with discussions led by the Kouga Municipality and various role players in Kouga to compile a COVID-19 action plan. A follow-up meeting will take place on Friday 20 March 2020 at 15h00 to discuss the measures and implementation of action plans.

There is currently confusion regarding the implementation of regulations as stipulated in the Government Gazette that refers to restaurants, pubs and places that sell alcohol.

After several enquiries from various role players the Kouga Municipality indicated the following guidelines. This may change in due time but currently this is how law will be applied.

- Licensed Restaurants may trade after 18:00 and proceed to serve food - **NO LIQUOR SALES/SERVING AFTER 18:00**
- Capacity is restricted to 50 patrons including all staff per business premises
- Capacity is limited to 1 square meter space per person on the premises due to social distancing as prescribed

The situation and regulations change daily, the KBF will provide information accordingly.
